Year 1	<p>Module 1 – Communication</p> <p>This module is all about finding and sharing information in different ways.</p> <p>Learners will join in a group discussion to raise their opinions and learn from other points of view.</p> <p>Learners will practice sharing and presenting ideas to others by writing, talking or drawing or even take on an editorial role and write for a blog or newspaper.</p> <p>RRSA 13, 14, 17</p>	<p>Module 2- My Community</p> <p>This module is all about playing an active role in your community.</p> <p>Learners could learn about local community issues and find out how they can help explore their local area and design a campaign to promote their community.</p> <p>Learners will have an opportunity to raise funds or volunteer their time to a cause that you care about.</p> <p>RRSA 13, 14, 15, 42</p>	<p>Module 3- Sport and Leisure</p> <p>This module is all about taking part in activities to support learners physical wellbeing.</p> <p>Learners will try a new sport or leisure activity that they would like to experience.</p> <p>Learners will need to keep a record of all the sport or leisure activities that they take part in.</p> <p>Learners will have the opportunity to take part in outdoor learning to broaden their skills in outdoor activities, such as Forest Schools.</p> <p>RRSA 12, 13, 14, 15, 31</p>	<p>Module 4- Independent Living</p> <p>This module is all about developing skills to live as independently as possible.</p> <p>Learners will practice doing things independently like washing and ironing your clothes, plan and prepare healthy meals and develop their cooking skills.</p> <p>Learners will do a range of activities some of which will be supervised to support them building confidence throughout the challenges set.</p> <p>RRSA 6, 13, 14, 17, 24, 26, 27, 28, 31</p>	<p>Module 5- My Environment</p> <p>This module is all about taking part in activities to appreciate and protect their environment.</p> <p>Learners will explore your local environment and visit parks and nature reserves nearby to produce an illustrated report on an environmental topic that they care about.</p> <p>Learners could make a wildlife area to encourage birds, animals or insects.</p> <p>RRSA 6, 17, 24, 27, 32</p> <p>Module 6- Number Handling</p> <p>This module is all about using numbers in real-life situations. (Viet Tet)</p>	<p>Module 12- Beliefs and Values</p> <p>This module is all about understanding different religions, beliefs and ethics.</p> <p>Learners will visit a place of worship and reflect on their experience and what they learned.</p> <p>Learners will organise a group activity to learn more about an aspect of faith.</p>
